

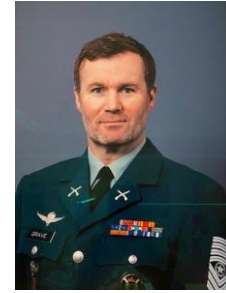


GENERAL INFORMATION

Gjert Grave

Master sergeant (OR-8) Gjert Grave was appointed as Command sergeant major (OR-9) of the Norwegian Home Guard on the 1th of August 2020. He is the third CCM in the Norwegian Home Guard.

CCM Grave converted from being an officer to be a senior NCO in 2017 after the implementation of the Norwegian NCO-Corps in 2016.

Command sergeant major Gjert Grave started his military career in 1998 at the Norwegian Army Non-commissioned officer's training school. After graduation he served in 2. Battalion in Troms. He deployed 9 months to Kosovo with Rifle Company as a team leader. Grave has also been an instructor at Non-commissioned officer's training school in Trondheim. He has also served as a team leader in Telemark Battalion.

In 2003 Gjert Grave went through the selection in FSK (Special operation command). In FSK Grave has been an operator for many years (2003-2019) and had several different positions. In this period FSK was heavily engaged in operations in Afghanistan. Grave served in Afghanistan in six deployments during this period.

Grave has also served at the national headquarters with focus on special operations (Deputy J 3.3).

2011 CCM Grave graduated from Norwegian Army military academy and he also graduated from Expeditionary Warfare School (USMC) in 2017.

His personal awards include the St. Olav's medal with oak branch, War medal, medal for defense service abroad with two rosettes for valor and leadership in combat.

Medal Armed Forces Medal for international operations, NATO Operations Medal for the deployments to Afghanistan six times,

The Norwegian Armed Forces International Operations medal for the deployment to Kosovo two times.

National Service Medal with three stars for more than 15 years of service in the army.

Command sergeant major Grave is married to Gerd, and he is the father of two.
